WARNINGS:

- 1. Authoritarianism
- be teachable.
- 2. **Exclusivity** we need each other.
- 3. **Greed** discontent, more than we need.
- 4. **Rationalization** don't lower the standard.
- 5. **Sensuality** be careful with the opposite sex.
- 6. **Unaccountable** you need to know you will be caught.
