[hagiasmos] - sanctification - set apart to God

B. The process

- 1. By the **Gospel** (Hebrews 10:10)
- 2. By the **Holy Spirit** (John 14:26)
- 3. By God's **Word** (Psalm 119:9)
- 4. By **continuing** (2 Corinthians 3:18, Romans 12:2)

C. What it is not

- 1. Happiness (James 1:2-4)
- 2. <u>Satisfaction</u> with the world (Mark 4:19)
- 3. **Answers** to life's big questions (2 Timothy 1:7)

D. What it is

- 1. <u>Holiness</u> set apart (John 17:16, 2 Thessalonians 2:13)
- 2. Pleasing to **God** (v 1b)
- 3. **Pursuable** (v 1b, Hebrews 12:14)
- E. What should we do?

- 1. **Believe** the gospel (1 Corinthians 6:9-11)
- 2. Follow the <u>direction</u> of God's Word (2 Timothy 3:16, Psalm 119:9)
- 3. <u>Live</u> a godly life (v 1b, Romans 6:19, 1 Corinthians 2:16)
- 4. Be in the **world** but not of it (John 17:15)
