 $[metoch\bar{e}]$ - (partnership) - a sharing; communion; fellowship

Common **salvation** - (Romans 3:23, 6:23, 5:8-11, 10:9)

Children of God - (Ephesians 1:5; John 1:12-13; Galatians 3:26)
