- \* Prayer = priority
- \* Prayer = difficult
- \* The Lord’s (disciple’s) Prayer

2. Don’t pray...

- \* “Teach us to pray”
- \* Don’t pray to be seen - Pray in secret
- \* Don’t use repetitious babble - God knows

3. Our Fathers honored name (Our first request)

- \* Our not my
- \* Father - identity
- \* Personal - intimate
- \* Heaven - God’s place
- \* Name honored - visibly demonstrate YOUR holiness & glory
