Remember who the enemy is. (John 13:35)

How to be unified

- 1. **Purified** souls (v 22)
- 2. Obey the **truth** (v 22)
- 3. Sincere **mutual** love (v 22)

A command (v 22b)

Love

[agapaō] - intensely vs. [philadelphia] - brotherly Supportive (Galatians 6:1-2)

Remember (v 23-25)

- 1. We are **family** (v 23a) (2 Corinthians 6:16b-7:1)
- 2. We have the **same** source of truth (v 23b)

God's Word (Hebrews 4:12; (Matthew 13:3b-11, 16-23)

Contrast (Matthew 26:38, 40-41)

3. Relationship **killers** (v 1) (Hebrews 12:1)

Evil/malice [kakia] - desire to injure.

Deceit [dolos] - decoy. Cunning, treachery.

Hypocrisy - [hypokrisis] - two faced.

Envy - [phthonos] - inappropriate jealousy.

Slander - [katalalia] - evil speaking, defamation.

4. Like **goals** (v 2)

1. Living like **family** (Romans 12:5)

Gossiping, complaining about leadership and decisions, criticism, cliques.
